

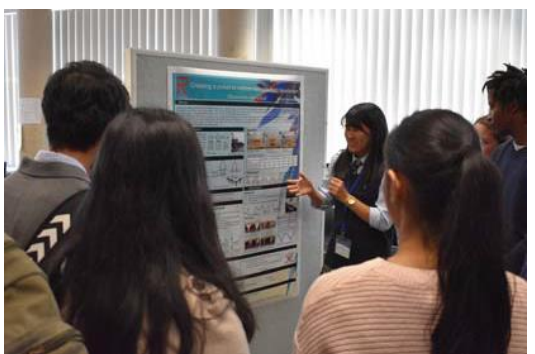


International Science Fair - Day One
