



Expectation of Students Selected to Participate in Student Exchange.

General Information

- Student Exchange programs consist of 2-3 weeks in homestay accommodation with the family of the exchange student who will visit Adelaide and stay with the ASMS student's family. The students will attend school with their exchange student.
- Student's families pay for and organise airfares, travel insurance, toiletries, sundries, shopping (souvenirs) and any large sightseeing tour.
- There is no cost for the accommodation, 3 meals a day, schooling, local transport and local sightseeing. If it is agreed that they travel somewhere with a large cost involved that will be your own cost (example, travelling to Tokyo by Shinkansen).
- Reciprocal arrangements for the International Exchange student.

Before the Event

- A meeting will be organised with all students and their families to meet and discuss travel arrangements so students will be together on flights to and from international country.
- **school exemption form to be completed and returned to the school for the principal's signature.**
- **There is no Teacher supervisor on this exchange.**
- The ASMS will liaise with the exchange school to share exchange student and family details. On receipt of the overseas exchange student details they will be shared with the ASMS student and family.
- Prior to student's departure, emails will be exchanged between families so students will already know each other before they leave.
- Students should take some Australian gifts to give to their exchange family. Examples - Plush toys, tim tams, fruchocs, caps, calendar, mug etc – even a jar of vegemite to get them to try!
- Students are supplied with some ASMS promotional gifts to give to other participants.
- Students are loaned an ASMS Jacket and tie/scarf to wear if the exchange school has a uniform to which the student must supply black pants or skirt and white shirt to wear.

After the Exchange

- Students are required to write an article for publication on the ASMS website and present at an assembly to share their experience with the school.
