



Expectation of Students Selected to Participate in Overseas Study Tours.

General Information

- Study tours consist of a 5 day event in dormitory accommodation supplied by the host school and 2-3 days cultural experience with accommodation in a hotel, students in twin or single rooms, teachers in separate single rooms.
- Students will be supplied with an itinerary covering the whole tour, Etickets, travel insurance certificate, copy of passport to take on the tour. Parents will be supplied with itinerary and travel insurance certificate.

Before the Event

- Most tours require a research poster and research seminar presentation for the Science/ Maths fairs. Research should be on existing Research Project, SIP or CS current curriculum – not extra work.
- Students must attend the Study Tour/Research Project Adventure Space from term 1 until completion to prepare their work. Your Study Tour teachers will assist in your preparations of your presentations.
- Supervising teachers will organise regular meetings with students to check on progress and deliver information. These meetings may be during lunchtime, Adventure Space or Learning Studies. All students must attend these meetings.
- Meetings will be organised with parents, students, supervising teachers and the ASMS International Manager to discuss the upcoming tour and requirements after student selections and a week prior to the tour departure date to confirm all details of the tour and deliver tour documentation.
- Students exchange mementos at the events so students are encouraged to take some Australian souvenirs such as lapel pins or mini koala toys to give away.
- Students are supplied with some ASMS promotional gifts to give to other event participants at the event.
- If students are in homestay accommodation they are required to take a thank you gift for their host family.
- Students are loaned an ASMS Jacket and tie/scarf to wear for presentations during the event.
- Students must supply black pants or skirt and white shirt to wear for presentations during the event.

- Students are supplied luggage details and airport requirements.
- Students are supplied copies of their eTickets, travel insurance certificate, passport, visa if required, itinerary for the fair and cultural experience section.
- Teachers will be supplied with copies of student's passports, visa, eTickets, travel insurance, home contact details, health care plans, student's mobile numbers.

During the Event

- Students are responsible for their belongings including passport
- Supervising teachers have Duty of Care of students during tour.
- Teacher will be supplied with an itinerary and transport guidelines for the cultural experience section of the Study Tour.
- Teachers will be supplied with itinerary, risk management procedures, local Australian Embassy details, local and ASMS contact details.
- Teachers will be supplied with visiting school and hotel contact details
- Teachers are supplied with first aid kit and asthma kit (if required).
- Teachers are supplied with mobile phone with main contacts installed for duration of study tour
- Students are required to write an article for publication on the ASMS website and present at an assembly to share their experience with the school.
